Sunday-Closing-Arrive after 3:00. Bring food for closing feast. Pilgrims come in @ 4:00pm



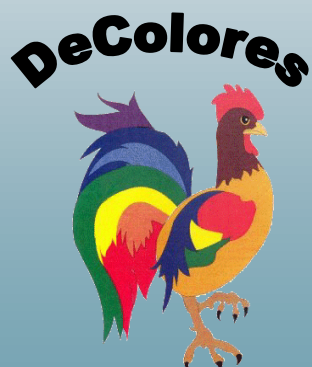
From the Board

entire weekend and pay the walk fee, or can potentially work shorter time periods, come and go from home, and pay only for meals eaten.
