Just Thinking by Natalie Lowe



Pilgrim Fees

Pilgrim Fees are due with Application.

The Emmaus Board of Directors approved a Financial Policy at the August Board Meeting. We have had issues the past few years with insufficient checks and who should pay the fees. The Emmaus Board stresses to please be financially responsible and respect the commitment that is made to Emmaus when you are sponsoring a pilgrim or when the pilgrim is paying the fee.

The men and women's registrars are responsible for collecting pilgrim fees. Applications and fees should be turned in together. Payments can be made by check, cash or paid through the Emmaus website via Pay Pal or Credit Card. If an application is received without payment (either cash, check or notification of payment via website), the registrar will contact the sponsor and advise them that the fee must be paid prior to acceptance of the application. There is a long history of sponsors and pilgrims paying the fee when they go to Sendoff. This was a practice in the past, but as of January 2015, the policy changed to the fee being paid when the application is received.

Thank you for your cooperation and prompt payment to enable us to good stewards of our financial responsibilities.
